<b>Project Overview:</b>	<p>The purpose of this project is to connect the existing Hoodlebug Trail to Indiana University of Pennsylvania (IUP) Campus, sporting fields and newly proposed new \$60,000,000 IUP convention center on University Drive. The Hoodlebug trail will connect the town of Indiana to Blairsville by 2005. The Indiana Transit Authority has just added bike racks to their buses through an enhancement project and the Transit Authority is half a mile from this trail.</p> <p>This project consists of a bituminous bike - pedestrian trail, prefabricated structure, and a ACOE-proposed ROTC rappelling wall. IUP is the project sponsor who will own and maintain the trail.</p> <p>The project involved close coordination among IUP, the ACOE, and PennDOT. The trail crosses a CSX track and also necessitated collaboration with CSX. Unique materials and techniques associated with this project include a pre fabricated steel and wood structure that maintains a rustic look.</p>
<b>Lessons Learned:</b>	This project is just a small portion of a greater bikeway project but it creates a necessary link that would otherwise not be realized.
