Project Overview:	<p>The project consists of signal replacements and streetscape enhancements which included granite curbing and planters, stamped and colored concrete sidewalks and crosswalks, tree lawns, filling of underground vaults, ADA considerations, benches, trash receptacles, bollards, tree grates, and period street lighting.</p> <p>The North Scranton Neighborhood Association (NSNA) was largely involved in the streetscape design of the project. NSNA coordinated and organized local residents and business owners throughout the design and construction process.</p>
Lessons Learned:	<p>When combining a PennDOT project and an Enhancement Project in the same area, we suggest having the same designer for both projects. This will streamline the process. By working with one designer you have an all encompassing project.</p> <p>During the design process, monthly progress meetings with the local sponsors helped tremendously to accomplish the goals of the project.</p>
Awards:	Scranton Chamber of Commerce Award was given to the North Scranton Neighborhood Association for their participation with the project.
