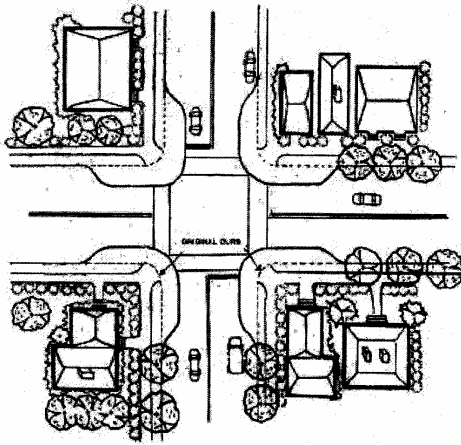


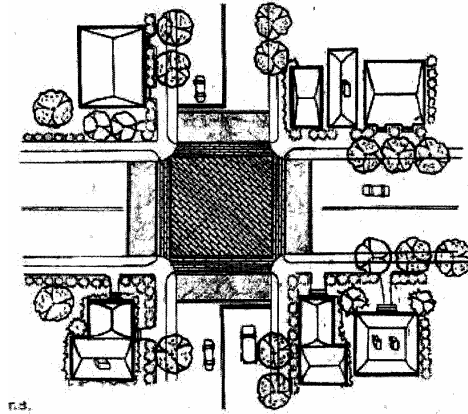
Traffic Calming

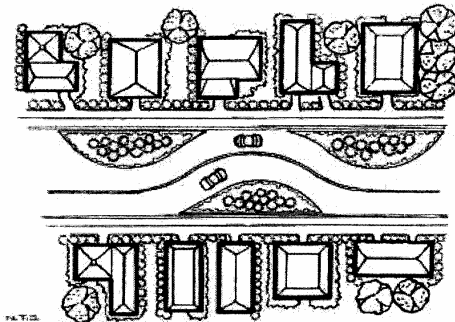
Bulb-Outs



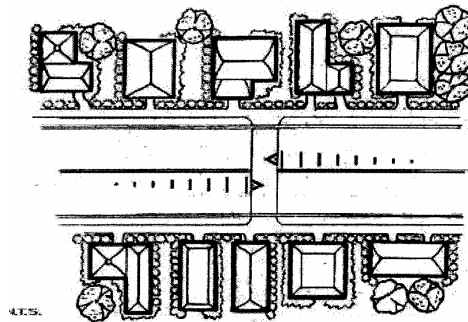
Raised intersection



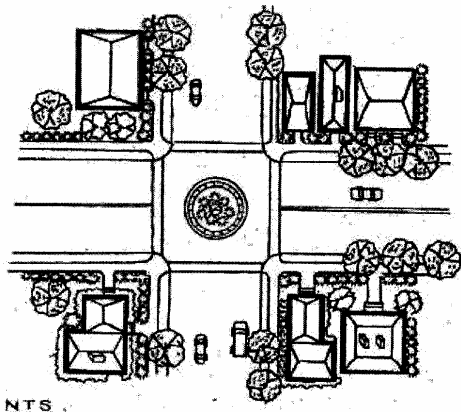
Chicane



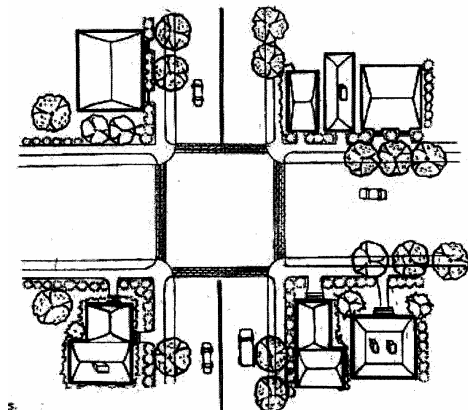
Speed Hump



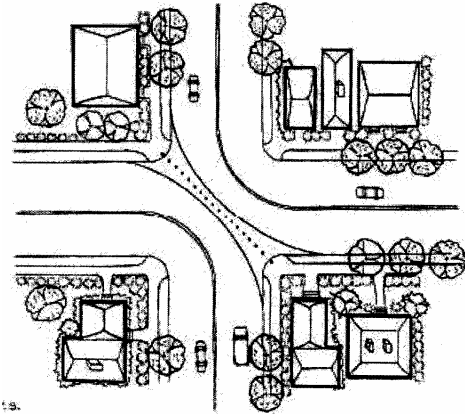

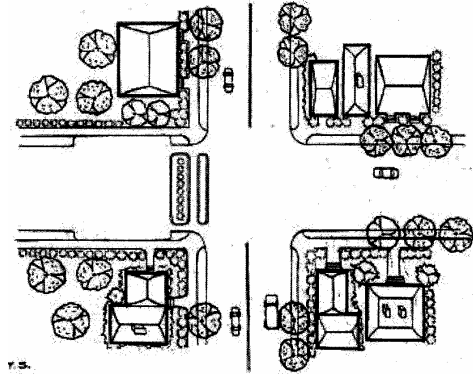
Textured Crosswalk



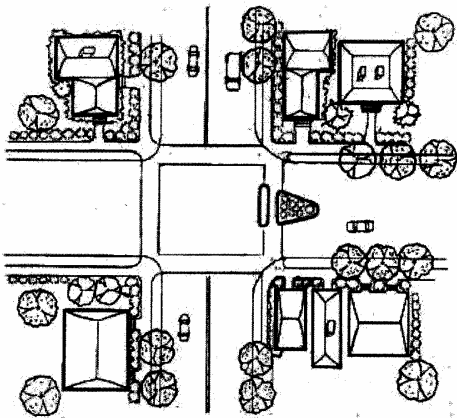

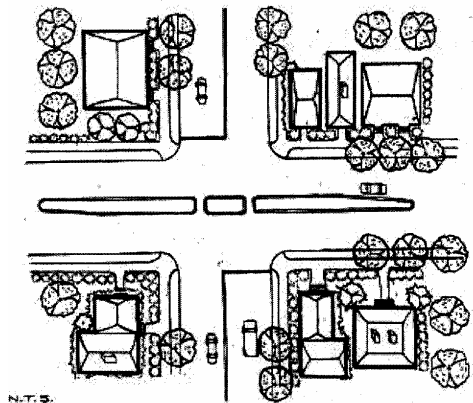
